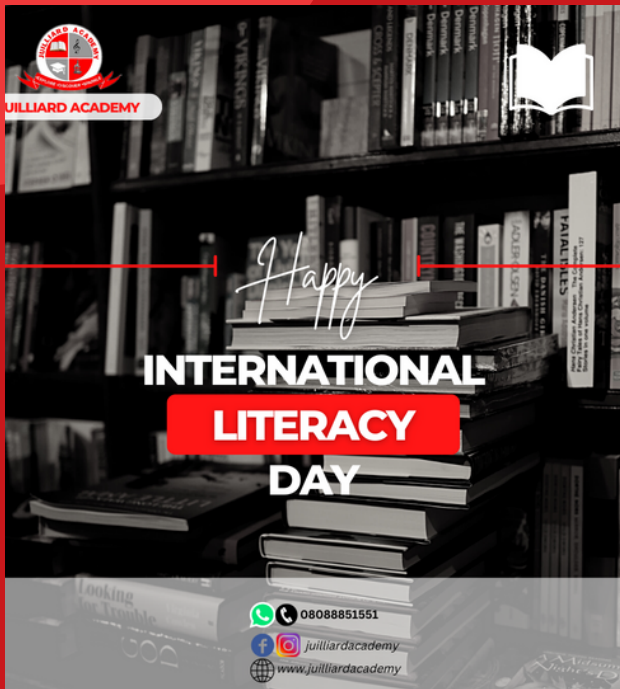
OPEN HOUSE

Midterm ASSESSMENT

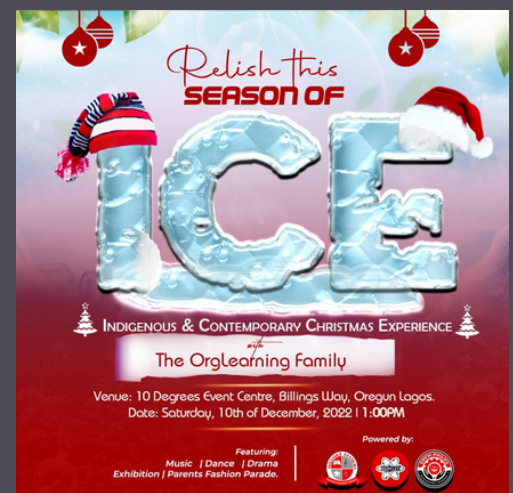
We bless God for the seamless conduct of the midterm assessment. The Portal will be made available shortly.
